Code Ann. § 7-1-101(28)(A) (Supp. 2023) defines "political party" to mean any group of voters that at the last preceding general election polled for its candidate for Governor in the state or nominees for presidential electors at least three percent (3%) of the entire vote cast for the office. In addition, Ark. Code Ann. § 7-7-205 sets forth petition requirements for new political parties.

Code Ann. § 7-6-223(a) (Supp. 2023) provides that within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of each calendar quarter, a political party that meets the definition in Ark.
