Monday, April 17, 2023	CPPC 1 st Quarter 2023 Report (covering the period January 1 thru March 31, 2023)
Monday, July 17, 2023	CPPC 2 nd Quarter 2023 Report (covering the period April 1 thru June 30, 2023)
Monday, October 16, 2023	CPPC 3 rd Quarter 2023 Report (covering the period July 1 thru September 30, 2023)
Tuesday, January 16, 2024	CPPC 4 th Quarter 2023 Report (covering the period October 1 thru December 31, 2023)

¹ Ark. Code Ann. § 7-6-201(6) (Supp. 2021) defines “county political party committee” to mean a person that: (A) is organized at the county level for the purpose of supporting its affiliate party and making contribution; (B) is recognized by an organized political party, as defined in Ark. Code Ann. § 7-1-101, as being affiliated with that political party; (C) receives contributions from one (1) or more persons in order to make contributions to candidates, ballot question committees, legislative question committees, political parties, political action committees, or other county political party committees; (D) does not accept any contribution or cumulative contributions in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) from any person in any calendar year; and (E) registers pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 7-6-226 prior to making contributions.

² Ark. Code Ann. § 7-6-226(c)(1) (Supp. 2021) provides that within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of each calendar quarter, a CPPC is required to file a quarterly report with the Secretary of State. In addition, Ark. Code Ann. § 7-6-225 provides that whenever a report becomes due on a day which is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the report shall be due the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.
